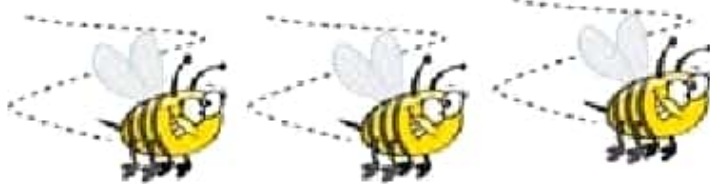

animals, or things.**

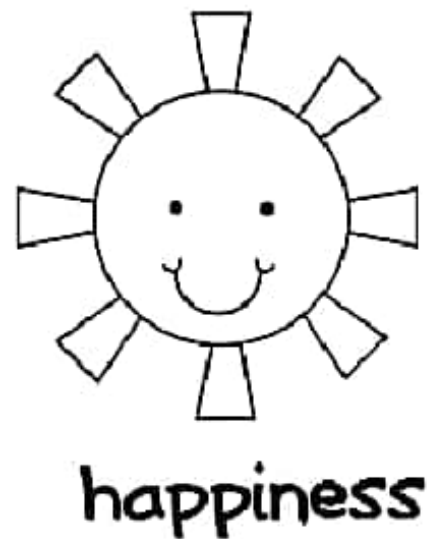
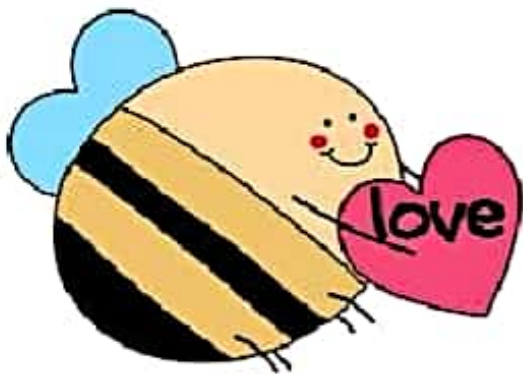


**Abstract nouns cannot be seen,
